Ice quake/ice ridge	The CAO advised that a meeting has been scheduled with Alberta Environment (and other interested parties) January 22 <sup>nd</sup> at the Seba Beach Administration office followed by site inspections of key locations of the affected shoreline.

Ice damage cont. After significant discussion Council unanimously agreed that the short term obligation of Council is to make sure that the Province is aware of the seriousness of the situation as it relates to the damage to the shoreline and the structural damage to properties within the municipality adjacent to the shoreline. We need to be diligent in finding a solution to give to our residents regarding reclamation and or remediation. Councillors Schultz and MacPhee will be attending the meeting to ensure that our interests are well represented.

Rural Crime Mayor Thomas provided Council with an overview of the January 11<sup>th</sup> meeting attended by himself, CAO Sue Evans, Evansburg RCMP Detachment Commander, Sergeant Brian Topham, RCMP Chief Superintendent, K Division, John Ferguson and Assistant District Commander, Western Alberta District, Lyle Gelinas. The meeting was held in response to concerns raised by Mayor Thomas specific to the inadequacies of the bail process among other issues of rural crime concerns. Members advised that they heard the concerns loud and clear and are moving ahead with strategies to improve the system as it is now.

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
